SECOND ANNOUNCEMENT

The Loess Plateau of the People's Republic of China is one of the most unstable landforms in the world and erosion is one of major problems. So too are the food production demands being made on this region to cope with a sustainable development. After two successful conferences on farming systems of the Loess Plateau held in Lanzhou in 1987 and 1991, respectively, the third conference on similar topics will be held from June 14-18, 2011. You are invited to attend this upcoming event. The conference is organized by College of Pastoral Agriculture Science & Technology, Lanzhou University, Gansu Grassland Ecological Research Institute and the Key Laboratory of Agro-Grassland Ecosystems, Ministry of Agriculture, China, and sponsored by the Chinese Academy of Engineering.

The conference will provide a valuable opportunity for the exchange of knowledge, including the discussion of sustainable development on the Loess Plateau. It will generate interest and international linkages between researchers, extension staff and policy makers. A post conference tour is planned to view the Hexi Corridor oasis and desert grassland systems, the Tibetan alpine grassland systems and the Loess Plateau farming systems.

The conference will provide a stage for young and established researchers to present their works in front of the welcoming international audience by both oral and poster presentation. The oral sessions will include invited and contributed papers.

All papers are to be submitted electronically and are limited to a size of no more than three A4 pages, including key points, introduction, materials & methods, results & discussion, conclusions and references sections. Times new roman with a size of 12 points is to be used, with line spacing

of 18 points.
